Currently, the rental fees for Empower House make up close to 50% of ENoK's annual budget and expenses. For the upcoming 2019-2020 year, ENoK is looking to purchase its own facility. This will allow ENoK to become a better steward of the valuable resources that all its generous supporters continue to entrust by turning their financial gifts into an investment instead of simply using them to pay off the rent fees. This will allow ENoK to focus more of its resources and energy on improving its programming and services to the refugee friends besides housing.

All the profits from ticket sales for this event will go to support ENoK's effort to purchase the new home for the North Korean refugees under its care.
